There are 4 main issues i see with the current system of accreditation of IMG s

- 1.the same people who recruit and pay for the recruiting of an img also supervise and verify their competence .this is a conflict of interest .it should be performed by doctors who are independant
2. The time taken for the supervision is a large imposition on doctors who are usually overworked in an area of need
- 3 the greatest need is in areas which have no doctor , and therefore no supervisor
- 4 I t appears there is widespread discussion amongst potential IMGs on the content of the PESCI's there needs to be more varied cases.

Ps on an unrelated matter .basing area of workforce shortage / area of need status to council areas is fundamentally flawed . Country council areas often cover a very small area of the population they service

Surprisingly ,country doctors spend a considerable amount of time working in non medicare funded medical areas such as delivering babies anaesthetics emergency care in public hospitals .
