My wife and I are strongly opposed to the draft code of conduct suggested by the Medical Board of Australia.

Some of our reasons are:

- 1. All Australian Doctors would be required to be "culturally safe" which does not equate to medically safe.
- 2. That means that the doctor would have to comply with the patient's beliefs about gender identity and sexuality.
- 3. This would not allow the doctor to differ in their professional judgment.
