Medical Board of Australia consultation on the funding of external doctors' health programs

Question 1: Is there a need for health programs?

Do you see any value in, or need for external health programs for medical students and/or doctors? Please explain your reasoning

Yes-I definitely see value in an external program. Doctors are notoriously poor at caring for themselves and are at higher risk of mental health related issues (including suicide) which may impair their ability to care for their patients. Education and training is needed in this regard, commencing at medical school. I support external programs as many doctors and students are concerned at the implications of internal services and may be reluctant to seek help.

I personally feel that the more comprehensive services of the VDHP and Doctors Health SA should be the models that are followed. DHSA is a relatively untested model from what I can see but does appear to have had significant thought put into it.

Programs to enhance the skills of medical practitioners who assess and manage the health of doctors

Research on doctors' health issues

Publication of resources - maintaining a website, newsletters, journal articles
