These should only be performed by trained plastic surgeons – including the use of cosmetic injectables.

The only exception should be cosmetic removal of a skin lesion up to 1 cm diameter.

The only alternative is to create a formal training course, supervised by the College of Surgeons.

All cosmetic procedures should have a minimum cooling off period of 3 months. A short period, such as one week, will not increase the number of patients who reconsider and decide against the procedure.

All surgeons or other practitioners who practice cosmetic procedures should participate in a different insurance pool from other doctors.
