We are saddened that the proposed Code of Conduct for Doctors in Australia makes it incumbent upon medical professionals to respect diverse gender identities and sexualities. That is why we ask the Board to change the wording of section 4.8.2 to reflect that it is the patient himself who is to be respected; whereas behaviours, which can have serious health consequences, should not be respected but treated instead.
